The Bay County Board of Commissioners
are sponsoring **Waste Amnesty Days** on **March 23 & 24,**
2018 and **September 21 & 22, 2018** at the
Steelfield Landfill 7 a.m.- 4:30 p.m.

We will accept:

- Appliances (Air Conditioners, Dryers, Stoves, Washer, etc.)
- Construction and Demolition Debris (Concrete, Lumber, Sheet Rock, etc.)
- Garbage (kitchen garbage, food stuffs, etc.)
- Household Hazardous Waste (Pesticides, Paints, Used Oil, Fluorescent Tubes, Antifreeze, etc.)
- Recyclables (Batteries, paper, plastic, metals, computers, cell phones, etc.)
- Small Engine Containing Devices (Lawn mowers, weed eaters, edger's, etc.)
- Tires
- Trash (Furniture, carpet, clothes, etc.)
- Yard Debris (grass clippings, leaves, tree trimmings, etc.)



Regulations prohibit disposing of appliances, household hazardous waste, small engine containing devices and tires in landfills. The landfill accepts these items, but must process them separately from other waste. If possible, please stage these items in the load so that they can be dropped off at the designated area.

Tipping fees will not be waived for commercial customers. Commercial customers will be charged normal tipping fees. All loads that arrive in commercial vehicles or trailers will be assumed to be commercial in origin and will be subject to tipping fees.

New Program continues.... During the amnesty events, Bay County is targeting the clean up and disposal **tires and derelict vessels/boats**. If you have waste tires or junk boats and vessels on your residential (non-commercial) property please take advantage of our amnesty weekends to dispose of them at no charge. The removal of tires and vessels from private property will not only help beautify our area, it will assist the efforts of the Bay County Mosquito control Division by removing potential mosquito breeding sites .

Tires - During the amnesty events, tires will not be limited to ten per customer. They will be accepted at any quantity as long as it is from a residential/non-commercial address. * Note* The State of Florida requires a permit in order to transport over 25 tires at a time.

Boats/Derelict Vessels - Can only be disposed of by lawful owner. All engines and holding tanks must be removed prior to disposal. Boats with tanks or motors intact will not be accepted. If you have questions please call :
